A. Prioritization Discussion Continued

The Council and Leadership Team staff continued their discussion on project prioritization to which there were differing opinions on the order of priorities. Regarding Local Improvement Districts, the consensus was to continue the discussion in a year unless an opportunity in the Large Lot Industrial area presents itself. In terms of Charter Amendments Mayor Fitch and City Attorney Keith Leitz will draft language on nepotism, term limits, and extending the term for Mayor from two years to four years. Any potential amendment could go before the voters in May 2024. In addition, discussion took place on a letter from the City to CourseCo.

Mayor Fitch requested that the Council reach out to him if they have interest in switching their committee/commission liaison assignments.
