A. Discussion of Photo Radar as a Tool for Traffic Safety

Police Chief Devin Lewis, Public Works Director/City Engineer Jessica MacClanahan, and Police Lieutenant Curtis Chambers presented an overview of the Redmond Traffic Safety Working Group and the consideration of a traffic photo enforcement program.
