2. The committee discussed the Safe Routes to School program, specifically pursuing technical assistance or education grants. Lindsey will submit the application on BPAC's behalf by the due date.
3. The committee discussed the 'BPAC/Council relationship and action items' topic. Lindsey recommended a work session with City Council to review work plan progress items and any other topics BPAC would like to discuss with Council. This recommendation was discussed with the City Manager and supported. The committee will decide a date to bring a work session to Council, likely in the Fall to better align with Capital Improvement Project updates so it has the most impact.
4. Decision making among the group was discussed. Lindsey reviewed the committee bylaws with the group. The group reconfirmed that majority votes will carry decisions.
5. Lindsey provided an overview of the Transportation System Plan to the committee.

6. Committee discussed desire to implement code changes to bike parking standards. Will be discussed at next meeting.
7. Committee discussed needed bike lane striping on Quartz Ave to meet collector standards. Lindsey explained that lost parking for residential properties was not preferred by Council at the time.

### **CALL TO ORDER**

### **CITIZEN COMMENTS**

Two comments were received from Jinny and Robin regarding eBikes in the City Parks and their appreciation for BPAC's discussion around this topic. They also thanked the City for the work on Sam Johnson Park area (Central Dry Canyon Project). Jinny and Robin are part of the "Friends of the North Dry Canyon" group and expressed interest to work with BPAC and remain involved on similar interests.

### **DISCUSSION ITEMS**

1. The committee discussed the Safe Routes to School program grant application. Lindsey submitted the application and the City is waiting for a determination by ODOT.
2. The committee discussed the Safe Streets for All grant application. Lindsey submitted the application and the City is waiting for a determination by ODOT.
3. Lindsey provided an overview of the presentation to be used at the June 4 Deschutes County BPAC meeting. The committee provided various helpful input on the presentation such as adding information about eBikes and grants. Lindsey will finish the presentation prior to the June 4 meeting incorporating the committee's feedback.

4. Committee discussed desire to implement code changes to bike parking standards. Scott Ferguson offered to research codes and share with the group for feedback. A subgroup was discussed as a potential option. Will be discussed at next meeting.
5. Committee discussed desire for shared path etiquette signage along the Dry Canyon Trail. The committee would like to work on this and bring ideas to Council or Parks for implementation. A joint Parks-BPAC meeting was discussed. Lindsey said this would be possible likely in the end of Summer or early Fall.
6. Leslie recommended to move citizen comments to the beginning of the meeting. The committee agreed to generally do this, however wanted to reserve the right to keep lengthy feedback to a minimum by potentially incorporating a time limit and/or deferring it to the end of the meeting.
